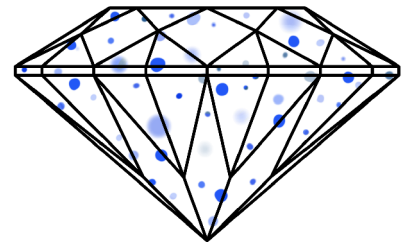

THE CAUSE OF COLOR IN YOUR GRAY BLUE DIAMOND

The **Blue and Gray** color of your 0.50 carat Pear shape diamond has a blueprint of the ocean, as it emanates from a significant amount of boron that originated from the prehistoric ocean floor. Boron atoms lead to the absorption of yellow light, which is at the opposite end of the color spectrum from blue. In some cases hydrogen is responsible for the gray color.



A WORD ABOUT THE SATURATION OF YOUR DIAMOND

The grade '**Fancy**' represents a level with a significant presence of color and accounts for **34%** of all Gray Blue fancy Color diamonds.

There are Three available saturation levels in Blue color diamonds, Fancy being the Second most saturated.



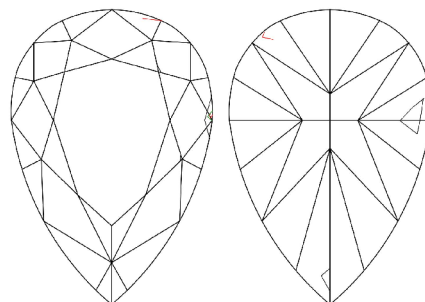

THE FUNDAMENTALS OF THIS DIAMOND'S SHAPE

The **Pear** brilliant cut diamond is a classic shape that appeared in jewelry as early as the 17th century on nobles and royalty. The facet alignment on the pavilion is inspired by the classic Round brilliant, hence the name of this shape. Only **18%** from all Gray Blue fancy color diamonds are polished as Pear shape.



TRUE FACE-UP

The carat weight and physical size of a diamond are important factors in determining its value. However, when it comes to fancy colored diamonds, there is a tendency to prioritize other visual elements over their size, and as a result, the surface area of the face-up view is not always given high priority. Diamonds that appear slightly smaller are considered to be within the norm. However, diamonds that appear larger in relation to their weight will receive a premium.

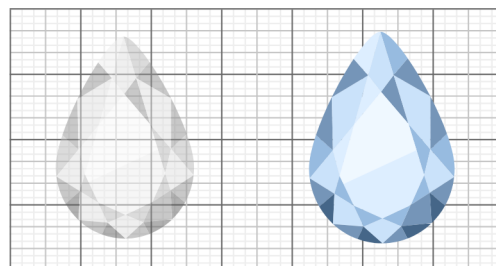

The Face-up of this 0.5 carat Pear is equivalent to that of a **0.57 - 0.58** carat which is **~15.0% larger** than the average Pear shape in this weight.

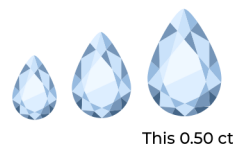

THE SI1 CLARITY IN THIS FANCY GRAY BLUE DIAMOND

Gray Blue Fancy Color Diamonds are extremely rare in nature and achieve their value from their captivating color. Unlike in colorless diamonds, the impact of a **SI1** clarity in Gray Blue fancy color diamonds is negligible as long as it is not visible to the naked eye. A Fancy Gray Blue with a SI1 clarity grade represents 18% of all Fancy Gray Blue diamonds in the 0.50 - 0.69 carat weight category.
