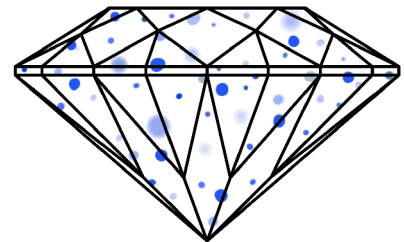

THE CAUSE OF COLOR IN YOUR BLUE DIAMOND

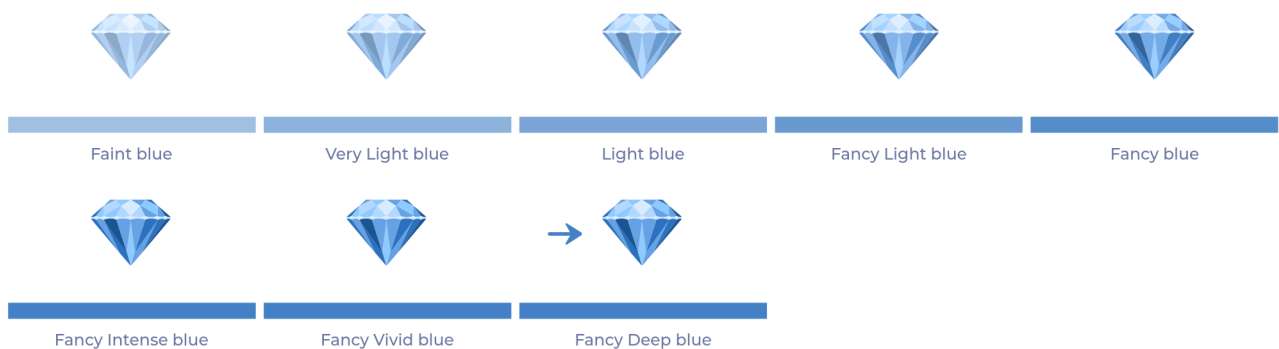
The **Blue** color of your 0.71 carat Oval shape diamond has a blueprint of the ocean, as it emanates from a significant amount of boron that originated from the prehistoric ocean floor. Boron atoms lead to the absorption of yellow light, which is at the opposite end of the color spectrum from blue.



A WORD ABOUT THE SATURATION OF YOUR DIAMOND

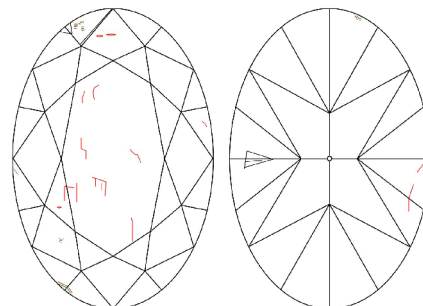
The **"Deep"** grade exhibits an extremely saturated color with a darker tone. This grade represents only **4%** of all Blue diamonds. Fancy "Deep" Blue diamonds give a profound color sensation.

There are Eight available saturation levels in Blue color diamonds, Fancy Deep being the Eighth most saturated. Fancy Deep is as saturated as Vivid; however, it presents a darker tone.



THE FUNDAMENTALS OF THIS DIAMOND'S SHAPE

The **Oval** brilliant is, in fact, an elongated version of the classic round brilliant cut diamond. The classic Oval brilliant cut is usually performed on colorless diamonds and is yielded from elongated rough diamonds. Only **20%** of all Blue fancy color diamonds are cut and polished as Ovals.



TRUE FACE-UP

The carat weight and physical size of a diamond are important factors in determining its value. However, when it comes to fancy colored diamonds, there is a tendency to prioritize other visual elements over their size, and as a result, the surface area of the face-up view is not always given high priority. Diamonds that appear slightly smaller are considered to be within the norm. However, diamonds that appear larger in relation to their weight will receive a premium.

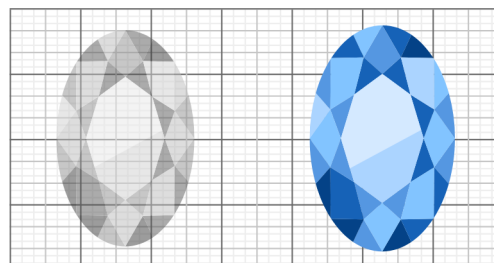

The Face-up of this 0.71 carat Oval is equivalent to that of a **1.12 - 1.15** carat which is **~59.8% larger** than the average Oval shape in this weight.

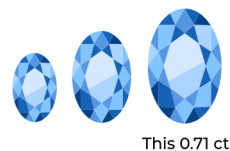

THE SI1 CLARITY IN THIS FANCY DEEP BLUE DIAMOND

Blue Fancy Color Diamonds are extremely rare in nature and achieve their value from their captivating color. Unlike in colorless diamonds, the impact of a **SI1** clarity in Blue fancy color diamonds is negligible as long as it is not visible to the naked eye. A Fancy Deep Blue with a SI1 clarity grade represents 15% of all Fancy Deep Blue diamonds in the 0.70 - 0.99 carat weight category.
