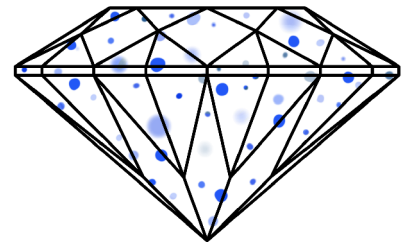

THE CAUSE OF COLOR IN YOUR GRAYISH BLUE DIAMOND

The **Blue and Gray** color of your 3.67 carat Oval shape diamond has a blueprint of the ocean, as it emanates from a significant amount of boron that originated from the prehistoric ocean floor. Boron atoms lead to the absorption of yellow light, which is at the opposite end of the color spectrum from blue. In some cases hydrogen is responsible for the gray color.



A WORD ABOUT THE SATURATION OF YOUR DIAMOND

The grade "**Fancy Light**" represents **38%** of all Grayish Blue fancy Color diamonds. Although referred to as "Fancy Light", these diamonds may exhibit a prominent hue, transcending color effectively

There are Three available saturation levels in Blue color diamonds, Fancy Light being the Second most saturated.



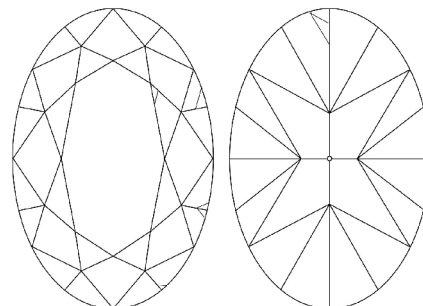

THE FUNDAMENTALS OF THIS DIAMOND'S SHAPE

The **Oval** brilliant is, in fact, an elongated version of the classic round brilliant cut diamond. The classic Oval brilliant cut is usually performed on colorless diamonds and is yielded from elongated rough diamonds. Only **19%** of all Grayish Blue fancy color diamonds are cut and polished as Ovals.



TRUE FACE-UP

The carat weight and physical size of a diamond are important factors in determining its value. However, when it comes to fancy colored diamonds, there is a tendency to prioritize other visual elements over their size, and as a result, the surface area of the face-up view is not always given high priority. Diamonds that appear slightly smaller are considered to be within the norm. However, diamonds that appear larger in relation to their weight will receive a premium.

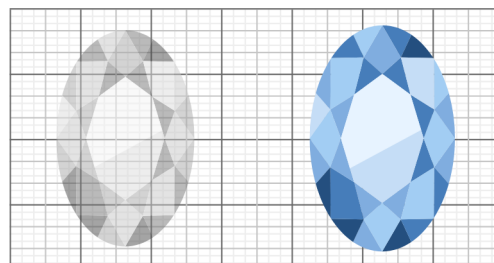

The Face-up of this 3.67 carat Oval is equivalent to that of a **4.47 - 4.56** carat which is **~23.1% larger** than the average Oval shape in this weight.

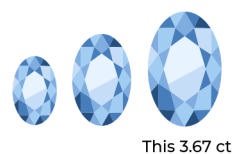

Grayish Blue fancy diamonds are extremely rare in nature. When they are manufactured with a high clarity grade such as **Internally Flawless**, they account for only 32% of all Fancy Light Grayish Blue diamonds in the 3 - 3.99 carat weight category.
