Much like the mythical moonflower, which blooms at night and returns to its normal state by dawn, this transformative quality derives its value not from traditional color grades or modifiers, but from its unique ability to transform. Collectors should know that their diamonds will exhibit a different color when placed undisturbed in a safe.

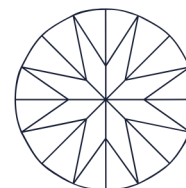
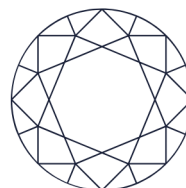
The grade **'Fancy'** represents a level with a significant presence of color and accounts for **44%** of all Gray Yellowish Green fancy Color diamonds.

There are Five available saturation levels in Green color diamonds, Fancy being the Fourth most saturated.

THE FUNDAMENTALS OF THIS DIAMOND'S SHAPE

Your 1.01 carat **round** brilliant cut diamond is cut and polished with the same facet alignment and an angle of colorless diamonds. fancy color **round** diamonds do not retain color the way modified fancy shapes do and as such, are rarely seen in weights above 0.10 carat. **round** fancy color diamonds in the Intense or Vivid grade fetch a significant premium in comparison to similar diamonds in other shapes. TRUE FACE-UP

The carat weight and physical size of a diamond are important factors in determining its value. However, when it comes to fancy colored diamonds, there is a tendency to prioritize other visual elements over their size, and as a result, the surface area of the face-up view is not always given high priority.

Diamonds that appear slightly smaller are considered to be within the norm. However, diamonds that appear larger in relation to their weight will receive a premium.

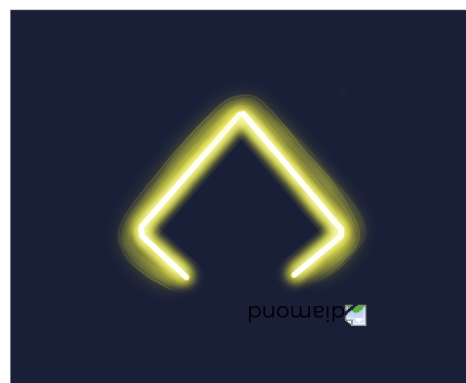
THE SI2 CLARITY IN THIS FANCY GRAY YELLOWISH GREEN DIAMOND

Gray Yellowish Green Fancy Color Diamonds are extremely rare in nature and achieve their value from their captivating color. Unlike colorless diamonds, the impact of low clarity in Gray Yellowish Green fancy color diamonds is negligible as long as it is not visible to the naked eye. A Fancy Gray Yellowish Green with a **SI2** clarity represents 15% of all Fancy Gray Yellowish Green diamonds in the 1 - 1.49 carat weight category.

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THE VERY STRONG YELLOW FLUORESCENT IN THIS DIAMOND

Fluorescence refers to the emission of visible light when a diamond is exposed to UV light. The fluorescence of this diamond is caused by the presence of trace elements within the lattice of the diamond. When a diamond is exposed to UV light, these elements absorb energy from the UV light. They become excited, and as a result, release energy in the form of a yellow glow. **Yellow** fluorescence reinforces the color of this Gray Yellowish Green diamond and will entail a price premium. The stronger the yellow fluorescence, the more attractive the diamond will be.
