A WORD ABOUT THE SATURATION OF YOUR DIAMOND

The **"Deep"** grade exhibits an extremely saturated color with a darker tone. This grade represents only **5%** of all Green Blue diamonds. Fancy "Deep" Green Blue diamonds give a profound color sensation.

There are Five available saturation levels in Blue color diamonds, Fancy Deep being the Five most saturated. Fancy Deep is as saturated as Vivid; however, it presents a darker tone.

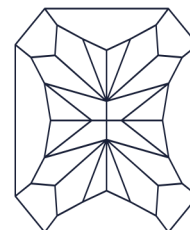
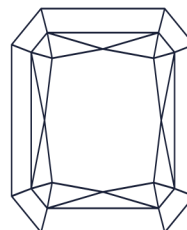

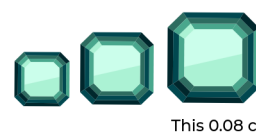
THE FUNDAMENTALS OF THIS DIAMOND'S SHAPE

The **Radiant** cut is a square or rectangular diamond with clipped corners, usually polished with a minimum of 59 facets. The Radiant is polished with a Starburst style pavilion, inspired by a round brilliant cut diamond, hence the name of this shape. **34%** from all Green Blue fancy color diamonds are polished as Cushion / Radiant.
