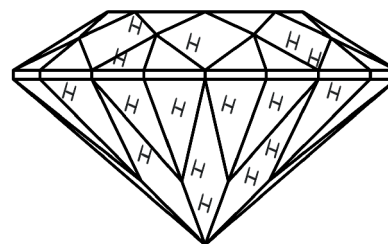

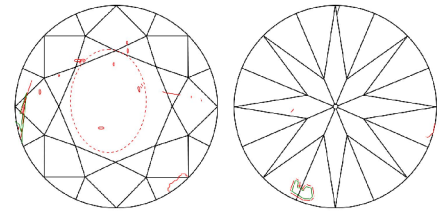

THE FUNDAMENTALS OF THIS DIAMOND'S SHAPE

Your 0.93 carat **round** brilliant cut diamond is cut and polished with the same facet alignment and an angle of colorless diamonds. fancy color **round** diamonds do not retain color the way modified fancy shapes do and as such, are rarely seen in weights above 0.10 carat. **round** fancy color diamonds in the Intense or Vivid grade fetch a significant premium in comparison to similar diamonds in other shapes. TRUE FACE-UP

The carat weight and physical size of a diamond are important factors in determining its value. However, when it comes to fancy colored diamonds, there is a tendency to prioritize other visual elements over their size, and as a result, the surface area of the face-up view is not always given high priority.

Diamonds that appear slightly smaller are considered to be within the norm. However, diamonds that appear larger in relation to their weight will receive a premium.

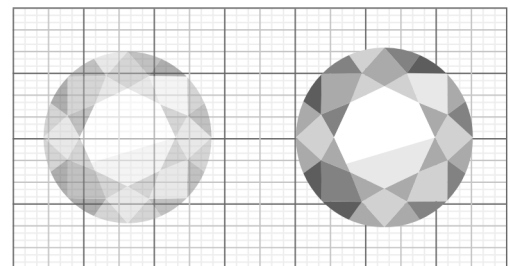

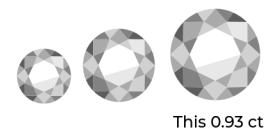
