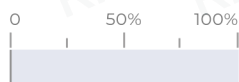

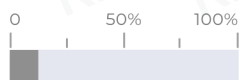

Market Distribution Percentage

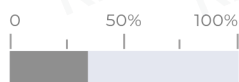
~ 0.5% of fancy color diamonds are Gray.



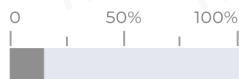
~ 12.9% of Gray diamonds are in the 1 - 1.49 ct. weight category.
