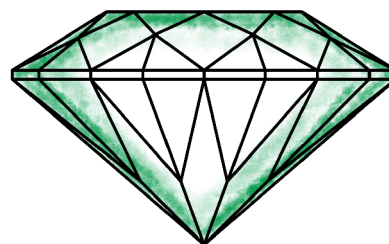

THE CAUSE OF COLOR IN YOUR GREEN DIAMOND

The **Green** color in this 0.54 carat diamond is typically caused by the absorption of red light waves, after a subterranean radiation exposure altered the atomic structure of the diamond, leading to its molecules absorbing red light and contributing to the green hue.



A WORD ABOUT THE SATURATION OF YOUR DIAMOND

The grade "**Intense**" is the Five strongest saturation on the scale and represents **18%** of all Green diamonds. Those graded as "Intense" Green exhibit powerful saturation and convey a strong color sensation.

There are Six available saturation levels in Green color diamonds, Fancy Intense being the Five most saturated.

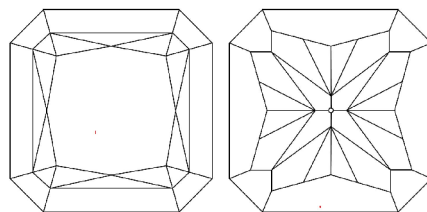

THE FUNDAMENTALS OF THIS DIAMOND'S SHAPE

The **Radiant** cut is a square or rectangular diamond with clipped corners, usually polished with a minimum of 59 facets. The term 'modified' refers to the fact that this stone is a modified version of the traditional rectangular Emerald-cut diamond. The Radiant is polished with a Starburst style pavilion as it creates a star shape when viewed through the table. This facet alignment is ideal for fancy color diamonds and gives the stone a special brilliance. Only **30%** from all Green fancy color diamonds are polished as Cushion / Radiant.



TRUE FACE-UP

The carat weight and physical size of a diamond are important factors in determining its value. However, when it comes to fancy colored diamonds, there is a tendency to prioritize other visual elements over their size, and as a result, the surface area of the face-up view is not always given high priority.

Diamonds that appear slightly smaller are considered to be within the norm. However, diamonds that appear larger in relation to their weight will receive a premium.

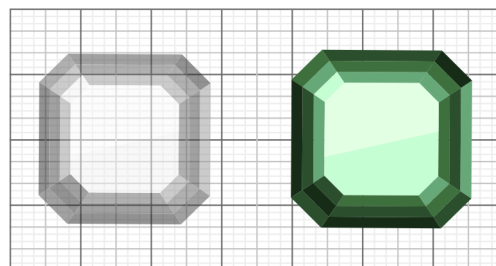

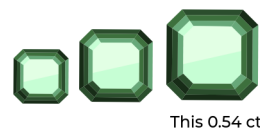
