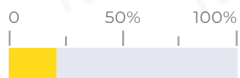

### Market Distribution Percentage

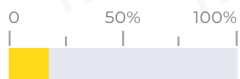
~ 69.8% of fancy color diamonds are Yellow.



~ 20.9% of Yellow diamonds are in the 1 - 1.49 ct. weight category.



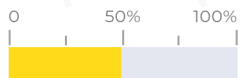
~ 17.5% of Yellow diamonds are graded as Fancy Intense.
