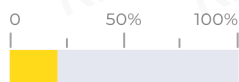

### Market Distribution Percentage

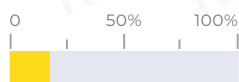
~ 66.9% of fancy color diamonds are Yellow



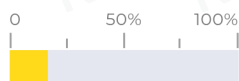
~ 20.6% of Yellow diamonds are in the 1 - 1.49 ct. weight category



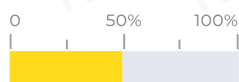
~ 17.7% of Yellow diamonds are graded as Fancy Intense
