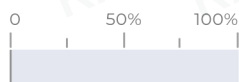

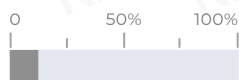

### Market Distribution Percentage

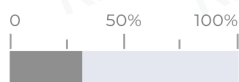

 Gray



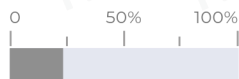
