

This special Collector's Edition report has been created in order to independently grade and verify the origin of natural pink and other colour diamonds from Australia's Argyle Mine.

The story of these diamonds is unique. They were discovered in 1979 on an anthill in the remote Kimberley region of Western Australia and have been coveted by jewellers, collectors and investors throughout the world. They have often been referred to as "earth magic".

The internationally accepted gemological standards used in this grading process will enable us to preserve the legacy of these beyond rare diamonds for years after the mine's 2020 closure.
