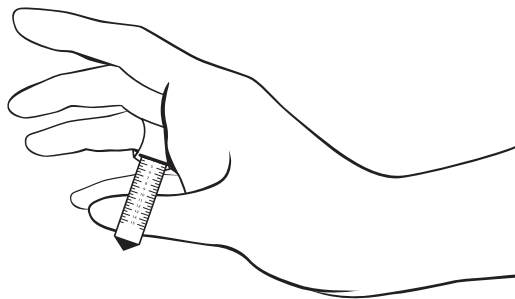
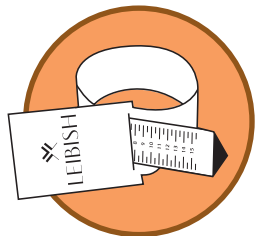
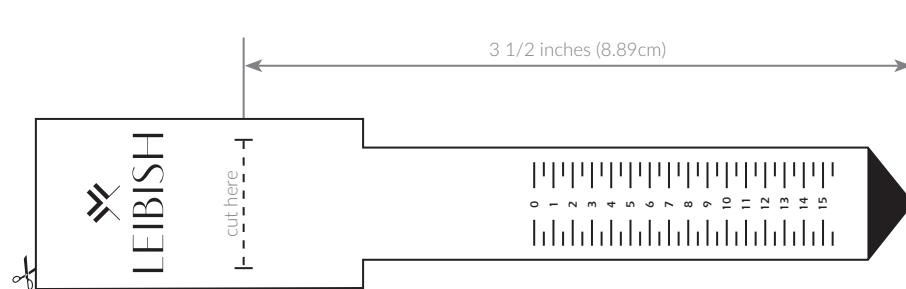

METHOD 1: PRINT A RING SIZER

HOW TO USE THE RING SIZER

1. Print the Printable Ring Sizer & Conversion Chart. Set page scaling to "100" in your print settings and use 8.5x11-inch standard paper.
2. Use the scissors to cut out your Ring Sizer, and cut along the dotted line to make a slit.
3. Insert the black triangle through the slit, making sure the numbers are facing the outside.
4. Place the Ring Sizer on the desired finger, pulling the black tab until it fits comfortably. It should not be pulled to tight.
5. Read the number that is closest to the dotted line. This is your ring size.



METHOD 2: MEASURE AN EXISTING RING

1. Choose a ring that correctly fits the intended finger.
2. Lay the ring over each size circle within the chart until you can closely match the inside edge to one of the circles on the guide.
This is your ring size! If the ring falls between two sizes, contact us to order the quarter size between them.

RING SIZE CONVERSION CHART

Millimeters are equivalent to the interior circumference of the corresponding ring size.
